Del Oro Water Company - Strawberry District 2013 Service Improvement Plan

UPDATED NOTICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD PRACTICE U-36-W OF THE CA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

Del Oro Water Company addresses, on an every other year basis, system-wide improvements, many of which are a result of aging infrastructure. Below is a summary of the projects that are scheduled to be undertaken in the 2013/2014 fiscal period. Included is our best estimate of the cost to complete these tasks, the total potential impact on rates, and a description of the facilities and/or

streets which will be addressed by this Capital Improvement Project.

In summary, Del Oro Water Company will immediately undertake:

- The Dymond Tank is considered a MAJOR EMERGENCY SITUATION
 and must be replaced at the earliest date in 2013. It has been failing and is
 now in IMMINENT DANGER of becoming non-operational. Failure of this
 tank could result in the entire District being without water for an extended
 period of time. Project includes the replacement and upgrade to a 350,000
 gallon bolted steel tank.
- 2. As required by the State Depart of Fish and Came, a one-time California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) environmental study must be performed [in addition to annually securing Tuolumne Utilities District's and PG&E's approvals] to pump emergency water from the Stanislaus River in 2013 and beyond. Failure to complete this survey will result in no emergency water supply being available to the District.



The total cost for both projects is estimated to be \$530,000. This includes a \$90,000 contingency factor that Del Oro is attempting to avoid spending, which may be necessary for the acquisition of additional land or the construction of an emergency booster station to temporarily transfer water until the new tank is constructed.

The rate impact is approximately \$18.21 per month for the average customer.
